Announcing the new Master's Degree in Instructional Technology (ITEC)

As schools adjust to the evolving demands of our *technological* society, the need for teacher expertise in Instructional Technology continues to grow. The new *Master's Degree in Instructional Technology* will prepare you to integrate technology effectively into your own classroom, as well as serve as a technology facilitator for other teachers in your school. You will never have to worry about the technology components on your teacher evaluation again! You will be prepared to use technology and help your students learn in more meaningful and relevant ways.

This program is aligned to the ISTE Technology Facilitation (TF) standards. You will complete performance-based assignments and field experiences in your school, allowing you to demonstrate mastery of the TF standards. Candidates must select a mentor who is capable of facilitating access to resources and opportunities necessary for completion of field experiences. The Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GaPSC) is developing a new field for Instructional Technology (ITEC), which should ensure that teachers continue to get paid for advanced degrees in ITEC.
