Cheatham Hill Elementary is a member of the Cobb County Public School System and it serves Kindergarten through 5th grade students. It is nestled inside a residential area not far from the historic Kennesaw National Battlefield Park.

Our school opened in 1997 with 950 students from Dowell, Milford, Fair Oaks and Still Elementary schools. Cheatham Hill currently houses over 1,050 students and will begin expansion of its campus in the fall of 2010. After completion of fifth grade, students feed into Smitha, Pine Mountain and Lovinggood Middle Schools and later Kennesaw Mountain, Hillgrove and Osborne High Schools. Our students bring a diversity of cultures and backgrounds and enhance our school with their academic and social contributions.
